- Books read must be accompanied by a parent signature **AND** a written response for **every other** book that you read. Mom or Dad can do the writing for you.
- Reading logs must be submitted to Mrs. Alexander on August 21<sup>st</sup>. **No late entries will be accepted.**
- Read as often as you like! The more books you read, the more entries you can earn!
